

How to Install your Flu Vaccination checker

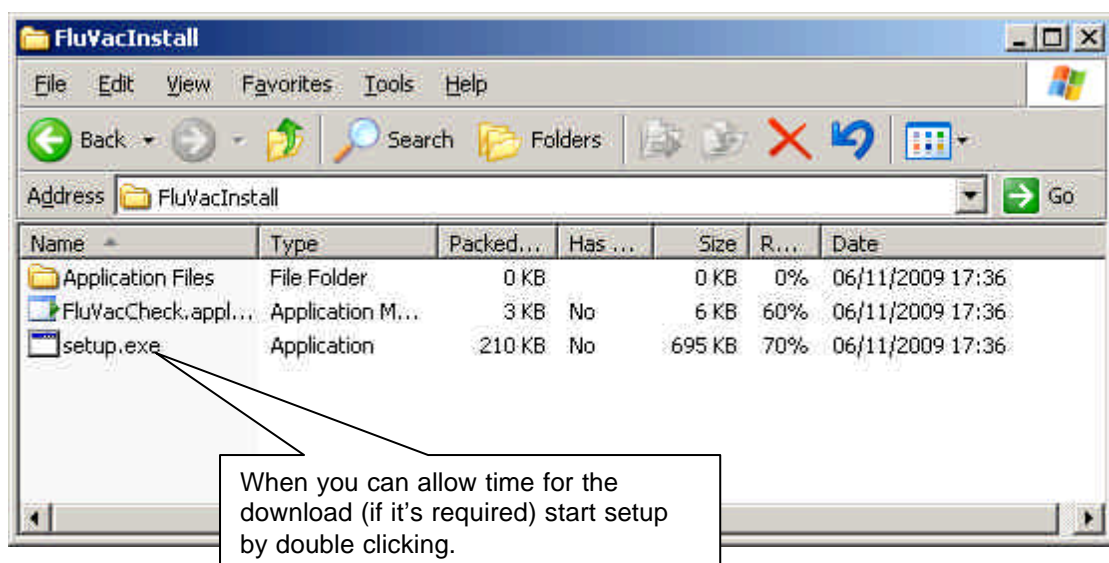
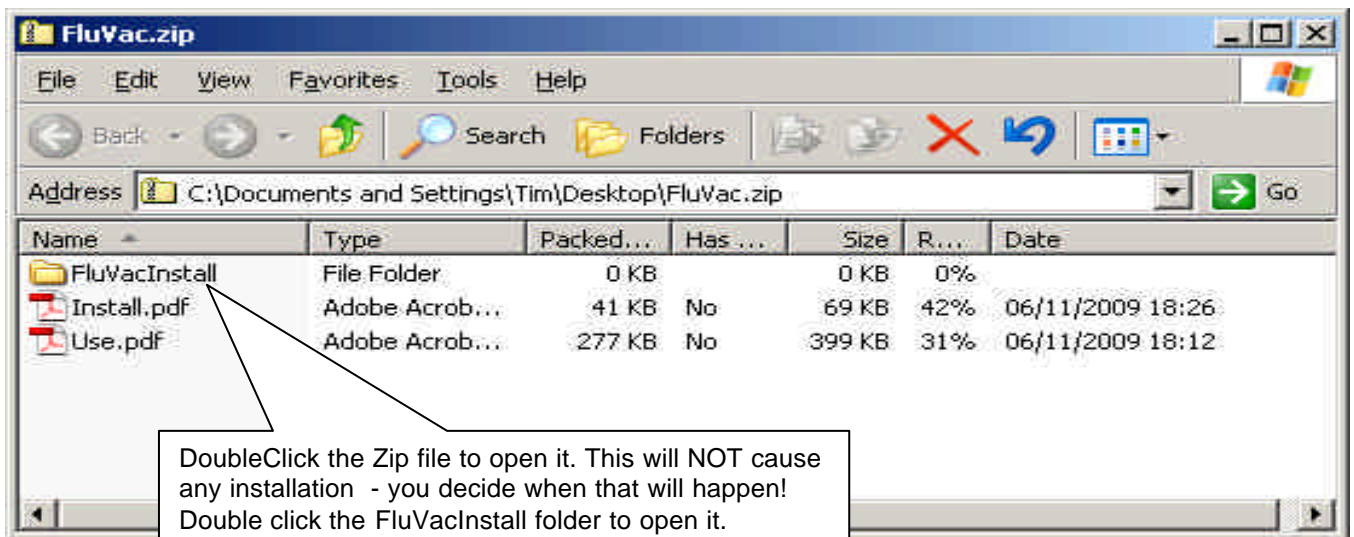
I regret this program is only available for Windows

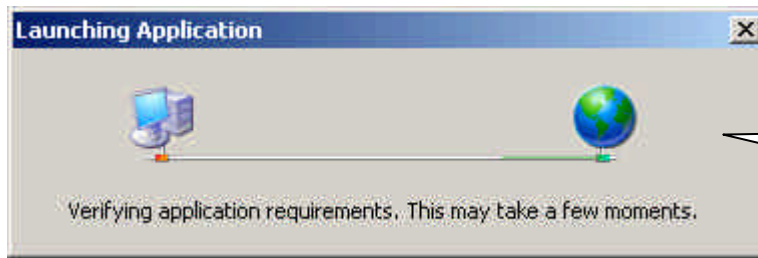
Download the zip file "FluVac.zip" and place it in a convenient folder (your desk top is ok)
Open the zip file – inside there are 2 pdf files – a copy of this one and one to help you get started with the checker.

The checker uses Microsoft's dotNet software. Most newer machines already have it installed but on some older machines the setup may need to download the files it needs from Microsoft. This is automatic but can take some time.

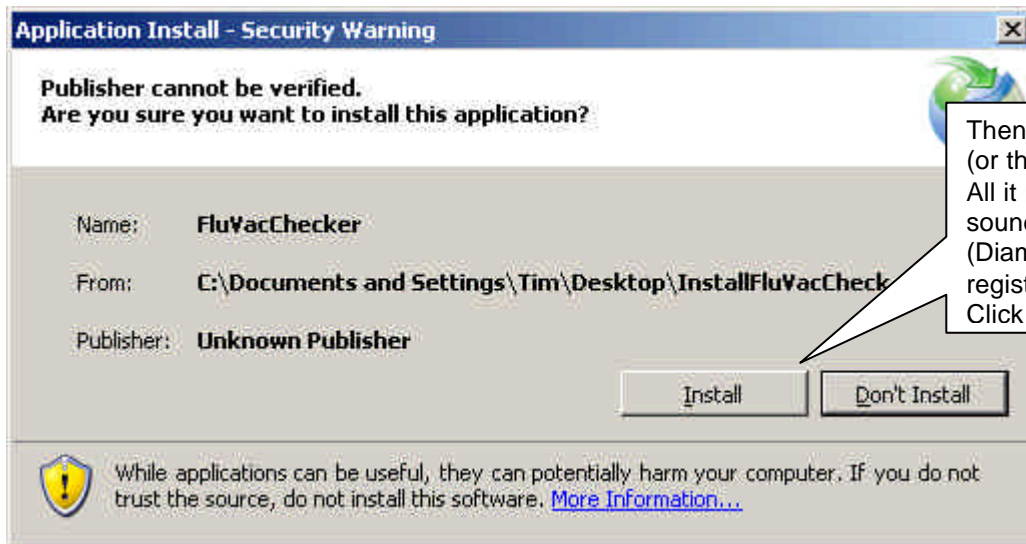
For example my old, slow, test machine took about 8 minutes to download the dotNet installation's 50Mb and 4 minutes to install them all. Time for a coffee!

If you want to install on a machine with no internet access, the full package is available on a CD from Sapphire Sounds at £5 to cover CD preparation, packing and postage. Installation instructions included.





You'll see this while setup checks what's available.



Then you'll see this warning (or the Vista or 7 equivalent). All it means is that Sapphire sounds software section (Diamond Digital) is not registered with Microsoft! Click Install.

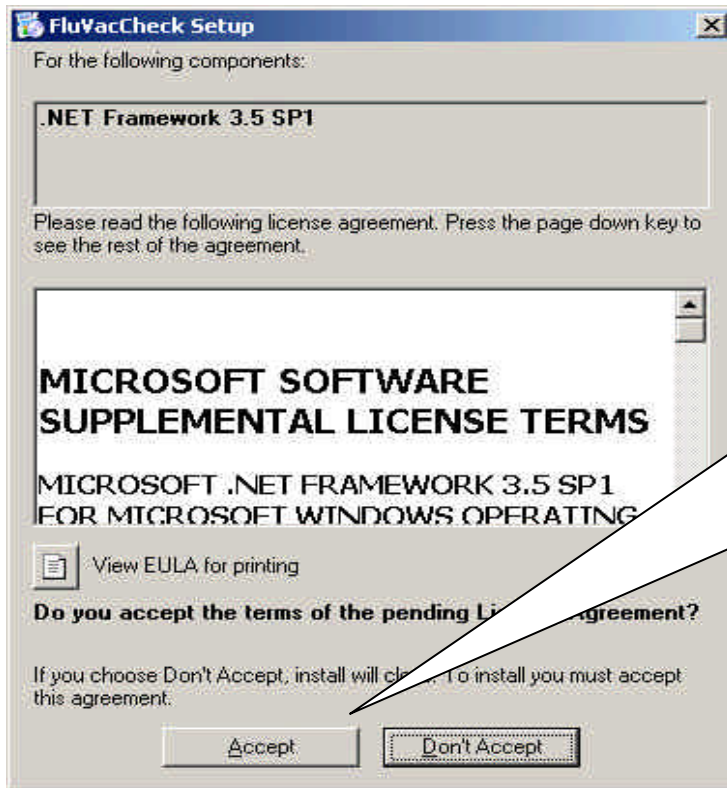
If you have the required dotNet files already the next thing you'll see is the Checker itself. Details for this are in the "use.pdf" file. Installation is complete so you should close this document now!

– If you decide to uninstall go to "settings" – "add and remove software" and click the "remove" button against the FluVacChecker. – but I hope you find it useful first!



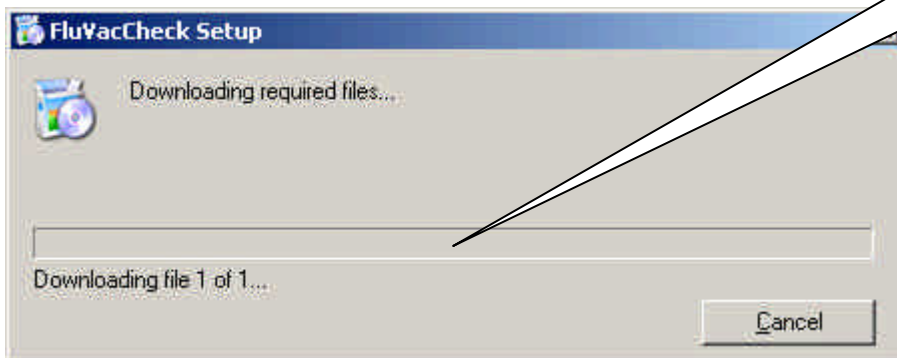
The rest is only if extra files are needed It is **AUTOMATIC** so **DON'T PANIC!**

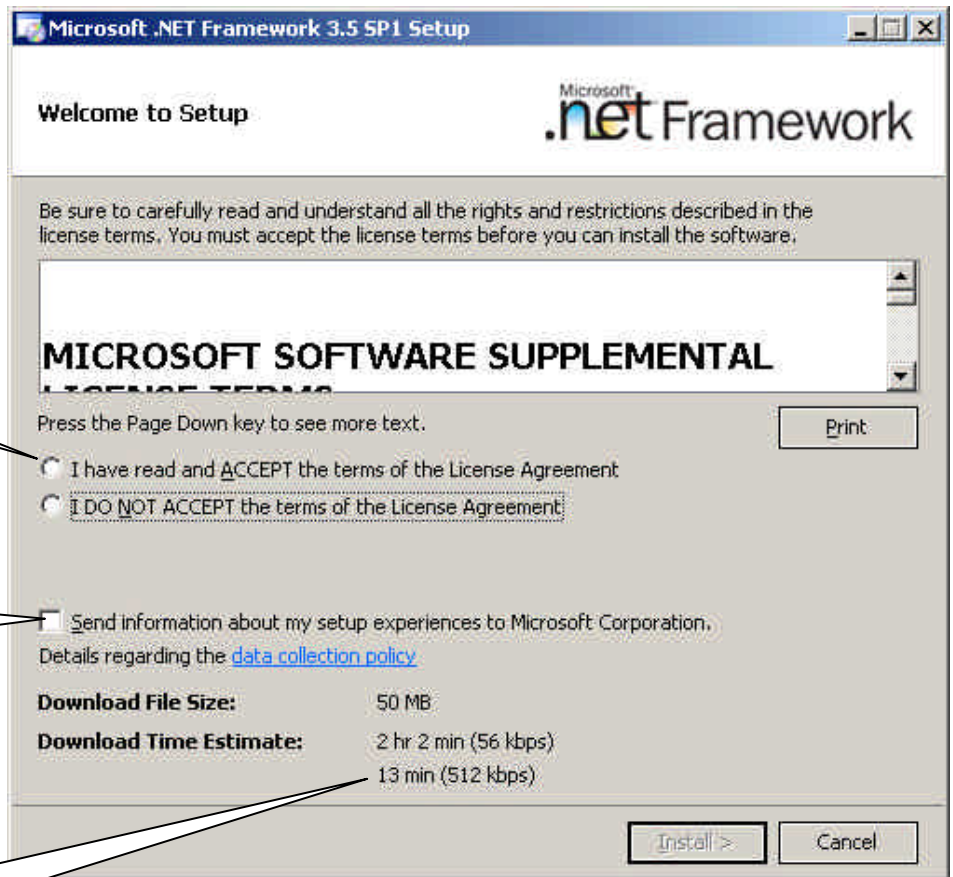
Vista and Windows 7 already have these files built in



If Files are needed setup will download them. Apart from a few "permission" buttons the whole process is automatic. Don't be put off by the way it looks. Typically it will only need one or two files, I've chosen to show you the "worst case" where a whole "Framework" is called up. This framework is a 50 Mb download. The good thing is that many programs use dotNet so this may save you time later! Don't forget you can still click "Don't Accept" here and order the CD!

How long you see this will depend on what you already have and how fast your connection is. Don't be impatient. If it really falls over it will tell you!

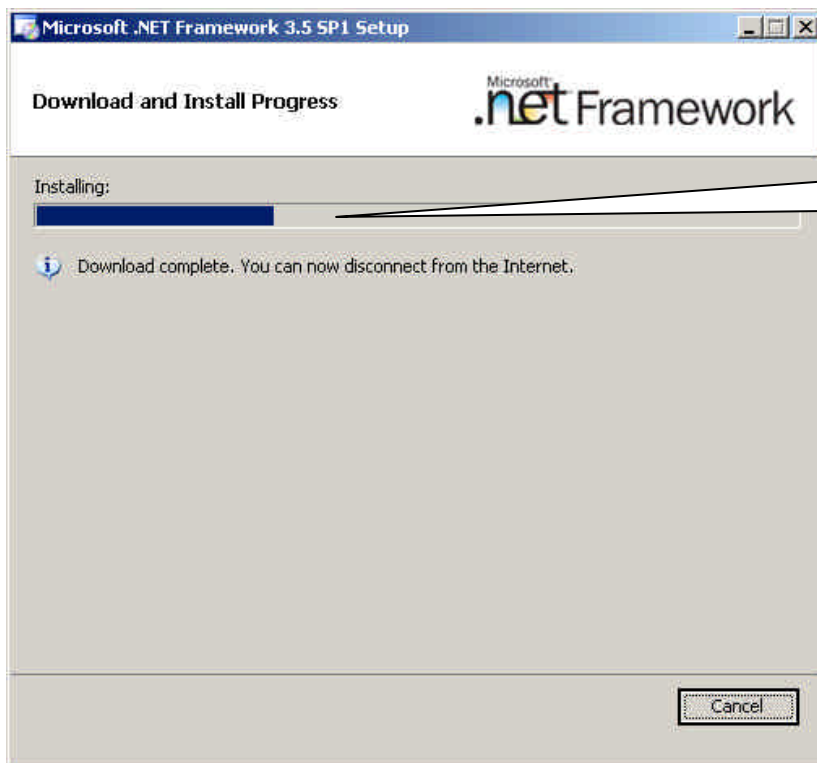




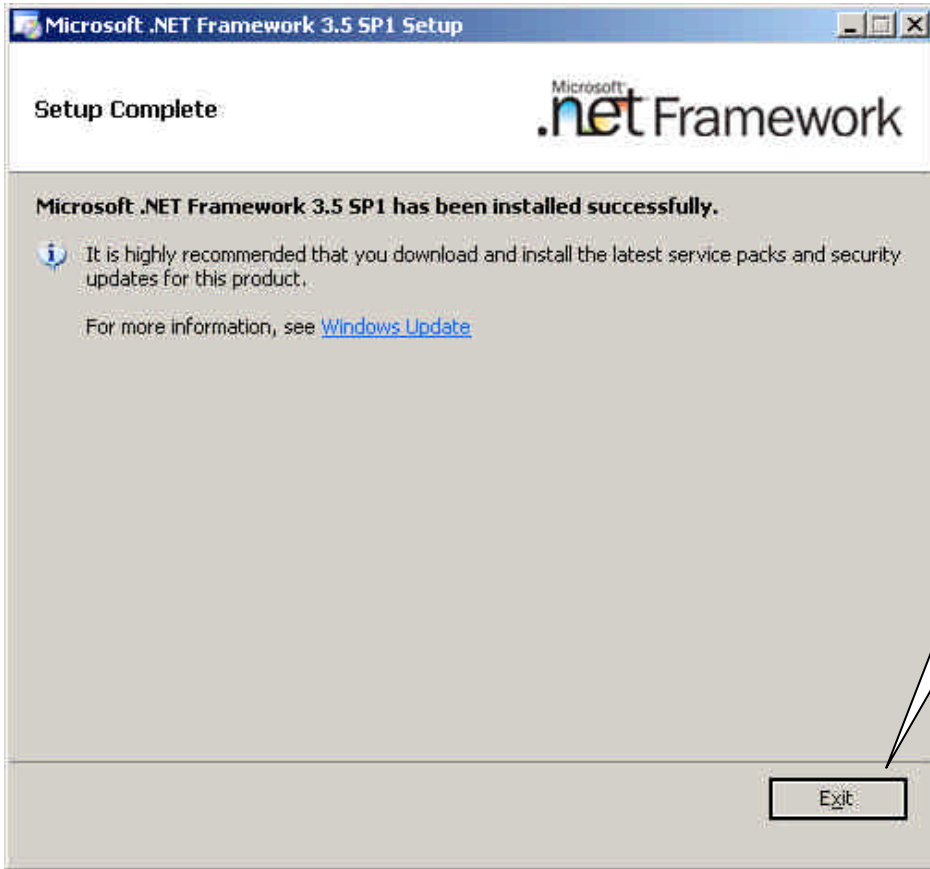
To go any further you will have to ACCEPT

But personally I never give Microsoft anything! Leave this blank!

My connection is not fast – even so it took only 10 minutes.



This may show for between 4 and 15 mins. 10 is typical



Once you click EXIT you should find the checker open already.



If not, look for the icon that looks like this
